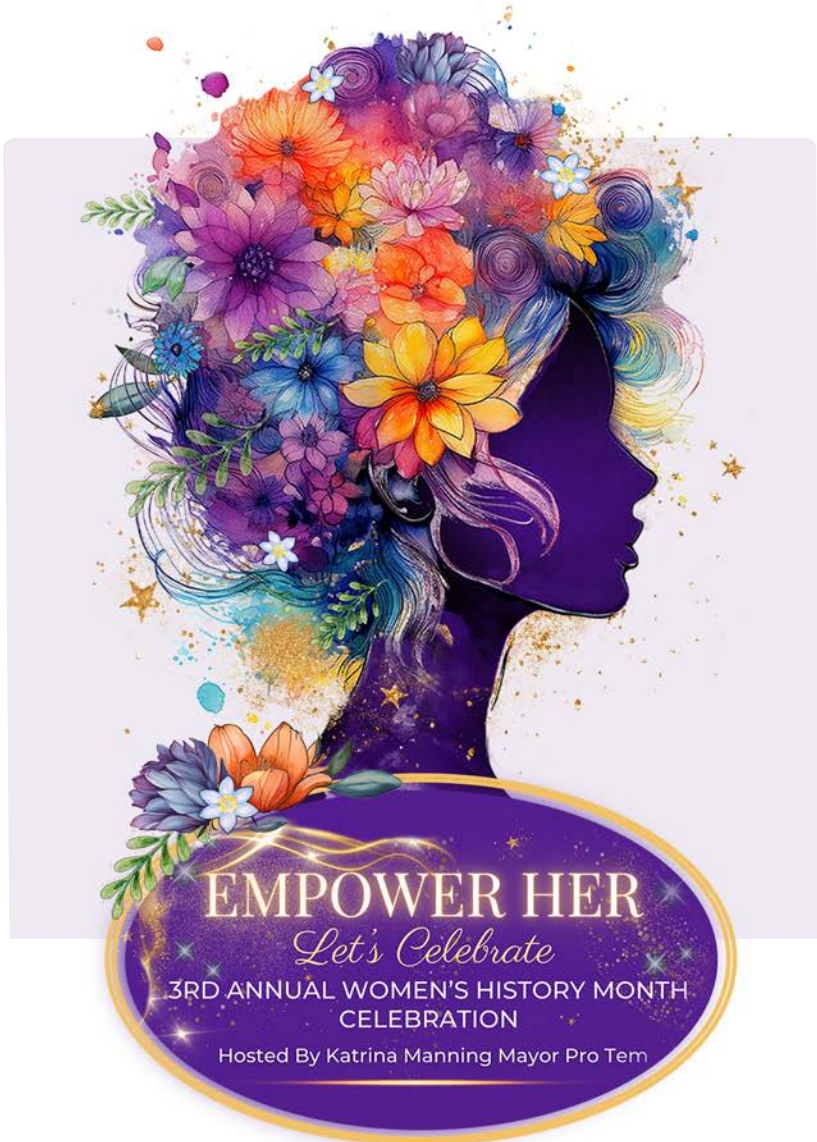

CEO Hotel Association of Los Angeles

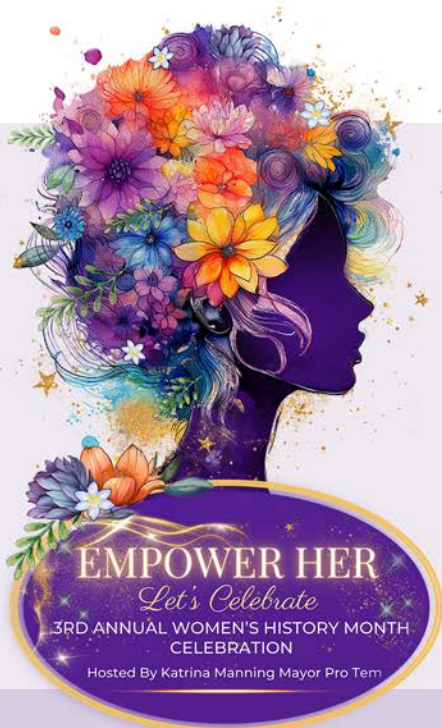
